LONG-TERM CARE TRANSFERS

A CHEAT SHEET OF STEPS FOR ED NURSES

QUICK: MAIN POINTS

- 1. **Pink Band/Form = Living in Long-Term Care** (a facility with **FT nursing care**)
- 2. **Call # on the pink band/form** to receive **report** from the LTC nurse.
- 3. Return completed bottom section of ED Transfer Form to LTC.

LOOK

for a pink band on the wrist

CALL the number

RECEIVE verbal handover

On incoming residents. The *Island Health COMPLEX CARE Resident ED Transfer Form* will also be printed on **pink paper**. This means they're **from a long-term care home**.

Written on the **pink band** and/or the top of the *IH COMPLEX CARE Resident ED Transfer Form*. This number should give you a **direct line to the patient's transferring nurse**.

From the **long-term care nurse**, using IDRAW (see acronym below).

IF NOT ADMITTED TO IN-PATIENT complete & return

CALL, using IDRAW,

The **bottom section** of the *Island Health COMPLEX CARE Resident ED Transfer Form* to the care home with the discharged patient. Include all documents necessary for the facility to provide care.

The LTC receiving nurse and update them regarding the resident's care and current status, to ensure accurate communication.
