TRANSFERING TO THE ED A CHEAT SHEET OF STEPS FOR NURSES

QUICK: ITEMS TO

SEND

- 1. IH COMPLEX CARE Resident ED Transfer Form (on pink paper)
- 2. Pink band on resident wrist (with nursing station phone number)
- 3. Other relevant documentation, including MOST orders.

COMPLETE on pink paper

The *Island Health COMPLEX CARE Resident ED Transfer Form*. Include **WHY** you're sending them, and **WHEN** they can return.

WRITE on the pink band

The **phone number the ED nurse can call** to reach you **directly** for handover. Place the pink band on the **resident's wrist**.

SEND with ambulance

All copies of *relevant documentation*, including the *MOST*.

USE the IDRAW tool

To verbally communicate the resident's status to the **ED Clinical Nurse Leader / Nurse Clinician**.

IF ADMITTED TO IN-PATIENT CARE UNIT

Call the hospital unit daily to discuss resident status and discharge plans (you <u>ARE</u> allowed to receive updates).

D - DIAGNOSIS +/OR CURRENT PROBLEMS

R - **RECENT CHANGES**

A - ANTICIPATED CHANGES

W - WHAT TO WATCH FOR
