

Covid-19 Script for Facility Greeters

Please complete the 2-step screening questions below for those wishing to enter the facility:

- Complete Step A for visitors, staff and contractors
- Complete Steps A and B for visitors

Step A: Screening Questions for EVERYONE – Illness/Travel/Close Contacts	Yes	No
• Do you have ANY respiratory symptoms, such as fever, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat or runny nose?		
• Have you traveled outside of Canada within the last 14 days?		
• Have you had close contact with a confirmed or probable case of COVID-19?		
• Have you had close contact with a person experiencing an acute respiratory illness?		

ALL questions in Step A must be answered “NO” to allow entry

Step B: Screening Questions for VISITORS ONLY † (children and youth excluded from visiting at this time)	Yes	No
• Is this a visit for compassionate end-of-life care?		
• Is this a visit to support care plans for a resident, based on resident and family needs?		

One of the questions in Step B must be answered “YES” to allow entry

† It is of paramount importance that we ensure the safety of our residents and staff. Therefore, in keeping with the Health Minister’s statement, we are implementing new visitor restrictions. (“**We are moving to restrict visitors in long-term care to essential visits only. Essential visits include compassionate visits for end-of-life care and visits that support care plans for residents based on resident and family needs, for example, families who routinely visit to provide assistance with feeding or mobility**”).
